## Description

JAMES WILSON, ASKRIGG Circa 1760. A good quality Georgian longcase clock with rarer birds eye maple veneers. A swan-neck hood pediment with central gilded finial. Hood and trunk columns. Canted base corners. Lovely colour and patination to the interesting wood grain. A brass and silvered dial with border engraving. An engraved dial centre with date and seconds. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. James Wilson of Askrigg (Yorkshire) is recorded in Loomes 'Clockmakers of Northern England' book as working from 1746-1781. A clock is illustrated in the book by him. Height 7ft 6 " / 229cms.
