Pal Fried (1893 - 1976). Pastel Drawing. SALE PRICE "Annabelle." C. 1930. 68 x 49 cms Image Fried Pal was a Hungarian artist whose paintings were usually of dancers and nudes. After his post-war immigration to America he also painted cowboys and landscapes of the American west. Pal Fried was born in Budapest, Hungary. He studied at the Hungarian Academie under Professor Hugo Pohl. Under Pohl's influence, he executed many portraits nudes and oriental scenes in pastel. Fried moved to study in Paris under Lucien Simone and was greatly influenced by the French Impressionist school of Renoir and Degas. He spent many years traveling throughout Spain, Africa, France, Algeria and Jamaica. Each place he traveled to enriched his palette and gave him mastery of light and movement. Pal Fried spent most of his married years on 76th street and West End avenue in New York City. Every month Fried's wife would hire a limousine and chauffeur to take his paintings to the Arnot Galleries on 57th street. At one point Mr. Arnot simply purchased a car for Pal Fried at the car dealer across the street from the gallery! As Fried aged he began to lose his eyesight. Mrs. Fried took care ...
