It has a silver handle with foliar design and a horse-hair bristle. It would have been used for removing dust etc. from top hats or bonnets. A lovely piece for the collector of Victorian daily life. Condition :- Very good. the bristle is in fine condition, with barely any wear and the handle has no splits or holes, although there are a couple of dimples to the cartouche (photo 2), commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Maker :- Saunders & Shepherd. Length :- 16.5 cms.
