Description

Lovely Antique 18th Century Period Oak Livery Cupboard or Wardrobe and dating from around the time of George 11 c1740. Originally a Livery cupboard and now with a hanging rail for use as a large double wardrobe it has a cornice top above two doors each with moulded arched panels to the top and smaller panel below and to each side is a quarter reeded column. Internally there is a hanging rail and it has its original oak pegs. The base is moulded to the top above three false fronted drawers and over two short drawers and one long drawer all of which are oak lined with later gilt brass handles. It is moulded to the base and has panelled sides and stands on bracket feet. It is hand and peg joined and the top separates for ease of transporting. Measures: 77" high x 23" deep x internal depth 19" x 53" wide A lovely early 18th century Livery cupboard (or wardrobe)and in very good original condition with a lovely deep colour and patination and oozing all the charm and character of the period.
