A chamfered pediment surmounted by an acorn finial. A cast brass bezel to the 8" painted dial. A twin fusee mechanism with 5 pillars and shaped plates of 8-day duration. Hourly bell striking with pull repeating cord. Alexander Milne of Aberdeen is recorded in Whytes 'Scottish Watch and Clockmakers' book as working from 1820-1842.
