The base is made from silver plate, with the full makers mark for the well renowned, quality silversmith, James Deakin. The underside also retains the original fasteners marked "Sheffield". The stand is exquisite with repousse decoration, all hand-chased. The two side flute holders are supported by an Egyptian revival Sphinx. The central holder comes out of a central classical urn, with the original engraved monogram to one side. All in superb condition, this really is a show stopper!
