This Swedish Sectaire Abattant has to be one of the nicest pieces I've ever had. Just take a look at the magnificent interior. All the drawers are finely dovetail on the fronts & backs. The original colour is superb as are the veneers, which are Carolyn Birch. It dates to around the 1860's period & is in perfect original condition. All the locks & original keys are still there & they all work. I think it has to be left open, because of the stunning interior. I've seen these items being sold for well in excess of £10,000 in the more fashionable areas of London & none of them were anywhere as nice as this one. There is some intricate subtle carvings inside the interior, all around the outside & on all the escutcheons. It still has the original feet & the fall is very stable when dropped down. All the drawers work well & everything is original. Please examine & enlarge all the images to appreciate the quality of this piece.
