His work is included in the collections of the V&A Museum, National Maritime Museum and Tate Gallery amongst others. Sir Richard Rees 1900 - 1970, 2nd baronet was a British diplomat, writer and painter. Educated at Eton and Trinity, Cambridge, was an attache at the British Embassy in Berlin and the editor of 'Adelphi' in 1930. He drove ambulances in the Spanish Civil War, and served in the Royal Navy and French Navy in WW2, where he was awarded the Croix de Guerre. He wrote several books, was the literary executor of George Orwell, and exhibited at the Royal Academy.
