The top lifts to reveal a small storage area of folios, magazines, documents, reading glasses etc. and is held in place by a patented internal support bracket. To the top there is a presentation plaque which reads: "Presented to rev William Stott by the Church & Congregation of Battersea Park Tabernacle March 31st 1899".
