A Superb Quality mahogany inlaid Edwardian Period breakfront bookcase. The upper section with a breakfront cavetto moulded cornice and satinwood and ebony chequer band detail. The frieze having satinwood cross banding above three astragal glazed doors which enclose adjustable shelving to each section, again cross banded in satinwood. The lower section with three doors each with beautifully figured mahogany veneered central panels, again cross banded in satinwood, which open to reveal further shelved storage areas.
