Description

A stunning quality mahogany Late Victorian Cylinder Bureau cabinet probably by Edwards & Roberts of London. Having an upper section with a solid mahogany top and a brass gallery and boxwood line inlaid detail, above twin bevelled glass doors, opening to reveal a silk lined shelved interior. The lower section with a cylinder front having a beautiful marquetry and penwork inlaid panel, cross banded in satinwood. The sloping fall front similarly inlaid but with a central marquetry panel depicting musical instruments. The interior has well fitted compartments and drawers with a green leather writing surface, is accessed by an ingenious mechanism which opens the cylinder whenever the drawer is opened.
