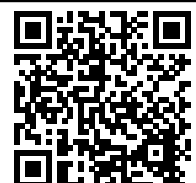

Carnelly. Birmingham Assay mark. Lion Passant. Date letter "x" for 1897. Dimensions and weight: 5cm x 3.5cm. 1.6 inches x 1.3 inches. Condition: Very good.
