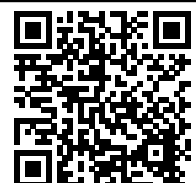

The well-figured coromandel-wood case, with its recessed handles and brass gilt mounts, opens to reveal the superb display of ELEVEN engraved hallmarked silver-topped bottles and jars arranged around the central tray of various tools and implements which include: 2 prs scissors; tooth pick; MOP penknife; needle case and other items. The tray lifts out to reveal a compartment for costume jewellery and there is a "secret" fitted jewellery drawer within the base. The lid contains the original easel mirror, and every fitting/content is immaculate; virtually mint condition.
