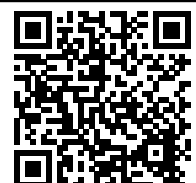

The stiles with well carved solid rosewood corbels. The right hand stile is hinged and serves to lock all the drawers with a Bramah style lock. The top with a beaded edge frieze and angled cornice with raised top shelf. Good warm patina, all original brass hinges, lock, fittings etc, mahogany lined, with keys.
