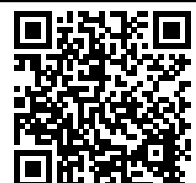
Description

A rare and elegant Gillows burr oak Davenport Circa 1849. The piece is signed to one of the interior drawers John Herbert a recorded and accomplished Gillows cabinet maker. The piece is veneered in rare English burr oak finished with a green leather tooled writing slope. The feet are gilded and particularly finely carved. Gillows made the original Davenport to fit Captain Davenports cabin aboard ship. This particular design features in the Gillows Sketch Book reference 5569 & 5570 and is thought to have been commissioned by Lord Cornwallis Lord Lieutenant of Kent.
