Description

An attractive and unusual small antique carved table from India circa 1900. Constructed from hardwood and heavily carved, it has a lotus carving to the centre along with a carved under-shelf. It stands on splayed legs which are also heavily carved. This attractive little table has the remnants of a label to the underneath which reads: "Ardeshir and Byramji Fort Bombay, 22 Oxford St London". The business of Jewanji Ardeshir and Cursetji Byramji was established c.1890 and were importers of Indian art until 1905 when the name of the business was renamed Ardeshir & Co. The business closed in 1909. Ardeshir & Byramji were recorded as exhibitors at the Chicago Exhibition of 1893.
