Very scarcely do we come by these particularly special antique Jaques travel chess boards, with their locking mechanism to keep all the chess pieces kept in place. Underneath the board is another plate which locks into the brass pins on the underside of each piece holding all pieces in place. The two single bone pins (one stained red and one natural) are pressed to release the chessmen for play to commence. Once finished, the four outer natural buttons are pressed in to lock the pieces in place, to enable this, you must ensure all pieces are in properly. The board frame is impressed with the famous "Jaques Patentee London" mark and opposite "In Statu Quo" and "Chess Board".
