Description

This small half of a saddle bag has beautiful soft, silky wool with highlights of silk in the lower right-hand cockerel. It is very much like the single ivory bird depicting the male bird - the dark birds representing females. The vegetable colours are superb and this ranks as one of my favourite 'cockerel' bags, made around 1870-1880 by Timuri tribes in western Afghanistan. Size: 56cm x 53cm (1' 10" x 1' 9").
