Pair of early C19th George III period mahogany hall-chairs. Elegant pair of simply-designed chairs constructed in heavy Cuban mahogany. Standing on turned legs with solid seats, the classical shaped backs with vacant moulded ovals for armorial decoration, with shaped scrolls above a stepped lower back. No crucial breaks to backs, though one chair has faded in sun-light and has an old repair to back panel. The reverse of backs carved with 'finger-grip' notches for moving.
