Either side on the silver plate is an English Design Registration diamond shaped lozenge, only added to pieces of notable design and quality, always making an English antique article even more highly desirable. The other benefit is being able to date a piece accurately, this design being registered, 17th January 1879, a true Victorian novelty gem.
