About as decorative as they get and created from two wonderful timbers, exotic Rosewood and Amboyna, the most expensive timber in the world, so this would have been made in it's day for a very wealthy client. The box dates to around 1830 and is William IV in era, the interior of the lid retains the period velvet lining and the box has been relined in a hand marbled paper. Amongst the intricate foliate inlay to the lid, a small central Mother of Pearl cartouche has been inlaid to the centre, with a complimentary shaped shell escutcheon to the front. The box comes with a working key (it seems to require two turns each way to lock and two turns to fully unlock). Beautifully decorative and in excellent condition. 12" x 9" x 4 3/4".
