This elegant antique firescreen has a mahogany frame and dates from the early 19th century. The oblong frame has 3 plain screens which pull out from both sides and the top. The central fixed screen has a tapestry scene depicting 4 figures in medieval costumes. The frame is raised on square section end supports, trestle base with applied roundels, downswapped legs with brass toes and castors joined by a turned pole stretcher.

Construction/Wood: Mahogany Condition Report: Wear and marks commensurate with age. Tapestry is faded and other panels have marks and wear. Small section of wood missing to top right panel.
