A superb set of sixed silver dessert spoons, made in the 18th Century. These rare examples are in Old English pattern and as is often the case with early dessert spoons, they are of a smaller size than their larger Victorian counterparts. To the top front are engraved initials 'S H'. With so much silver flatware having been scrapped and melted over the last two years, a matching set of six from this date is a rare find.
