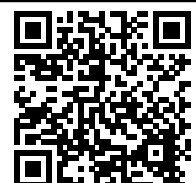
Description

A very large and impressive historical portrait of a WW1 British army officer, finished in generously applied oils onto canvas, seen posing for the artist in a relaxed manner, proudly wearing his full uniform with hands clasped gently together. The sitter is presently unknown with details unfortunately overpainted on the rear of the canvas, but the cap badge has been identified as that of the Cheshire Regiment (pre 1922). Clearly signed by the artist identified as 'Withers-Lee' and dated 1921 in the lower left corner.
