A wonderful late Victorian dressing table jar, it is unusual to find them with clear glass liners, but to find one with a Cranberry glass liner is even more unusual. The sterling silver caddy which holds the glass is pierced or reticulated and allows peaks of the wonderful rich colour to show through, especially when placed strategically allowing light to shine from the back. The lid fits well and is beautifully decorated with repousse or embossed work around a central vacant cartouche. The silver (top and bottom) have full hallmarks for Birmingham 1900 with the makers initials for the well renowned silversmith, Henry Matthews.
