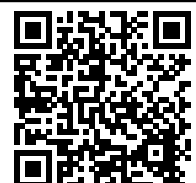

Both sit in their presentation case. Both napkin rings are fully hallmarked for London 1908, Edwardian in era together with the maker's initials, C & W, possibly for Cathpole and Williams. Heirloom quality and in excellent condition. Both a good size measuring 2 1/8" in diameter and 1 3/8" thick; the box measuring 4 1/4" x 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".
