The Silk and Satins of the Field - Publisher was Thos Mc Lean on 20th October 1868 and engraver J Summers. The original are part of the Paul Mellon Collection at the Yale Centre for British Art in America. Benjamin Herring was born into the family of great sporting artists in 1830.
