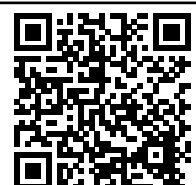
Description

An extremely good quality Victorian coloured print presented under glass of a childrens brass band playing ceremonially on the steps outside to a group of mourners, with a Chelsea Pensioner seen stood within the right hand margin. The ladies all wearing black satin dresses with head veils fastened back. A young girl is encouraged by the bands young boy conductor, to play with her hoop elsewhere, as the band prepares to march forwards. There are noticeably a doves seen fluttering above the heads of all the gathered and in particular, a bird on its own by the artists name. **CONDITION** Very good order throughout, with colours still strong and vibrant.
