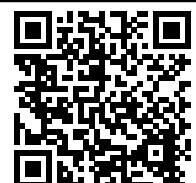
Description

The upper back rail is veneered in finest "flame" mahogany, with carved cresting and carved "ears" whilst the centre back rail is similarly carved. The upholstered seat can be raised at will via the long screw-thread, and it is supported on typical Gillows turned and reeded legs with delightful carved 'collars' to the feet. * A number of features of this chair can be found illustrated in "Gillows of Lancaster and London" by Susan E.
