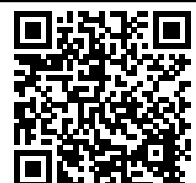
Description

An elegant antique George 3rd hanging corner cupboard oak with beaded central door panel and dentil cornice. It has brass H-hinges and escutcheon and working lock and key. Inside it is painted pale green and has 3 shaped shelves. Lovely warm patina to the oak. A good example dating from Circa 1800. Construction/Wood: Oak Condition Report: Nice age and colour to the oak. Scuffs and marks commensurate with age. Some small gaps and mends to the beading on the door panel. Small piece of dentile cornice missing. The door sits slightly proud at the top and bottom. Some old worm holes to the sides which have treated with worm killer as a precaution. Dimensions: Width Across Door: 23" Width Across Sides: 3" Depth Middle Front of Door to Back Corner: 12" Depth Edge of Front to Back Corner: 17" Height: 38.5"
