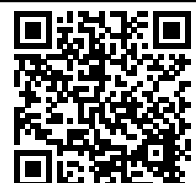
The Case The well proportioned slender case, constructed of beautifully figured quarter sawn oak. The stylish caddy topped hood surmounted by three original cast brass finials, with Greek key mould beneath. The hood door having attached turned pillars terminating with turned wooden capitals. The long trunk door with very good quality strap hinges. The box base with a shaped plinth.

The Dial The square brass dial is of elegant design with finely cast ornate spandrel mounts in the corners and a matted dial centre, with silvered axe head cartouche with makers name inscribed to the lower centre.
