A charming antique Edwardian oak bureau in golden oak. In a style similar to Libertys this beautiful piece of furniture has lots of character. The oak is quarter sawn to give a rich pattern of medulla rays to the front and sides. The fall is panelled and to the interior is a leather writing surface and pigeon holes. Unusually the fall rests on the drawers when open. The drawers have solid brass swan neck handles (antique replacements). Below the drawers are shaped openings for storage, books etc. Comes with key which locks the top. Dating from circa 1900. Construction/Wood: Oak. Condition Report: Solid, marks and scuffs to the interior and exterior commensurate with age. Small round holes filled in to top and sides (see pictures). Handles are good antique brass replacements.
