With a pronounced serpentine-shaped front with serpentine-shaped sides and canted corners it has four long drawers all with cock beading, circular brass handles and locks. With a nicely shaped apron and feet inlaid with boxwood and ebony line decoration. Overall a top quality example of its type with a beautiful grain and range of tones making this a lovely rich coloured and practical chest. It is in very good condition, there are small old scratches/nicks to the front of the top edge at the centre, and an old scratch on the right side of the second drawer. Unfortunately we do not have a key but all the drawers are unlocked. The inside of the top drawer is divided into three sections.
