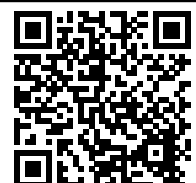
Asmalyks were made in pairs and hung on the flanks of the wedding camel during the wedding procession, afterwards presented to the bridegroom who would then hang it inside the wedding yurt as a symbol of power and fertility.
