Description

The 'Ru Korssi' was a decorative cover over a small square wooden frame under which were placed bowls of burning charcoal. The tribes-people would sit around the frame tucking their legs under the under-blankets and warming themselves! Ru Korssis were larger than the square flour soffrehs and this superb example woven in the early part of the 20th century is in mint condition. I particularly love the zig-zag effect which I suspect symbolised running water. Great natural colours, throughout. Size: 1.40m x 1.40m (4' 7" x 4' 7").
