Dorothy Burroughes (died 1963) - 'Ballerina', watercolour and gouache, circa 1930, stylised signature top right. In original ebonised frame. Dorothy Burroughes was an illustrator, designer and linocut artist. She contributed to a number of magazines including The Bystander and Illustrated London News. She became well known for her illustrations of animals, which appeared in numerous books in the 1920s and 1930s and designed posters for London Underground in the 1920's. She exhibited widely and in 1934 had a solo exhibition at The Fine Art Society. 35cm x 33cm including frame.
