Description

These come along only once in a blue moon, are always highly sought-after and highly collectible. Made by Hukin & Heath, very famous for the silver plated wares, many pieces of which were designed by Sir Christopher Dresser, as these piece may well have been. The last one I have (many years ago) was identical to this with the three hooks on the side, presumably for cocktail stirrers or lemonade spoons. My client at the time wanted to have a finished decorative piece and I had my (very skilled) silversmith make up a container and three spoons, I have done this again for the purchaser. These never came with a glass or container but this finishes the piece off if you wanted to display it. Equally, you can display it as originally meant, without the spoons and container. The underside of the stand is marked for Hukin and Heath and the English Design Registration Number for the year 1887 is present in several places. A magnificent find in excellent condition.
