Description

Early C19th late George III period mahogany sofa table. High-quality classic mahogany sofa table of very elegant proportions, standing on reeded swept sabre supports. Fitted two slim 'cock-beaded' frieze drawers with 'dummys' in reverse, all fitted original knobs, with reeded diamond decoration to ends. Desirable high 'invisible' stretcher and 'standard-end' supports with reeded panel reserves, fitted with square brass box-cap castors. Reeded edge to top, reeded stretcher, reeded legs and reeded mould decoration. The twin drop-flap ends each fitted with double 'fly' bracket supports, opening to form a completely flat and true surface. Excellent original colour and patination, in entirely untouched original condition. The drawer fronts fitted with bone 'diamond' escutcheons, a feature which alludes to a north of England origin, whilst the grade and choice of timber, quality of design and construction, all point to a possible 'Gillows' of Lancaster attribution. A wonderful table which combines function, elegance of design and practicality. As well as a centre or reception room table, could also be used as either a writing, drawing or dressing table, with the high stretche...
