Good quality mid 19th.c. classical brass statue of a man trying to tame a rearing horse c.1860. A popular subject, after the pair of huge marble originals commissioned by Louis XIV for the Chateau de Marly, they were produced in large quantities (and varying quality) during the 19th century and are often referred to as 'Marly horses'.
