A fabulous antique English egg cruet, one of the best I have had for a while. Lovely quality with a pierced or reticulated handle as is the gallery that runs around the side, all hand engraved. The stand sits on four stunning and highly decorative feet. The egg cups are all pierced with gilded interiors. The stand comes complete with six egg spoons. The underside has a full mark for PADLEY, PARKIN & STANIFORTH of Sheffield. Active (1846-1875) at 1 Watson Walk, Sheffield and 215 Salisbury Street, London. Succeeded to Padley, Parkin & Co. The firm used a "palm of hand" trademark acquired from J. Watson & Son in 1849 (Watson used this trademark since 1830).
