FULL WORKING ORDER. STANDS 85" HIGH. *SAMUEL DEACON (1746-1816) WAS A FAMOUS AND WELL WRITTEN ABOUT MAKER WHO MADE UNUSUAL STYLE MOVEMENTS WITH SHAPED BACK COCKS. HE WAS ALSO A BAPTIST MINISTER. HIS WORKSHOP STILL EXISTS IN THE LEICESTER MUSEUM.
