The ebony strung inlaid long trunk door with choice curled mahogany veneers, flanked by quarter turned finely reeded columns. Original watch and clockmakers label to the reverse of the trunk door. The box base surmounted on the original bracket feet. The circular white enamelled dial with gilded edge signed Cameron Dundee, to the lower edge. The high quality movement of eight day duration with shouldered and shaped plates united by four knopped pillars, anchor escapement and strikes the hours on a single bell.
