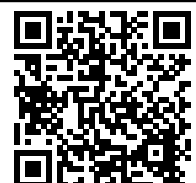
Description

It also has its original gilt bright cut hands and working date indicator, working original lock and winding key. The case is of fiddleback mahogany which has a wonderful deep colour and patina and the grain really does shine through. It runs for 8 days and is accurate to 15 seconds per day.
