A magnificent and early silver soup ladle from the reign of George II. This superior quality example is in Old English pattern with feather edge engraving to the handle and has a script initial 'A' to the top front and a lovely shell edge bowl. It is fully hallmarked and is a fine and useable piece of table silver. Useable 18th Century silver is becoming harder to find and early items from this date are particularly scarce. Condition :- Excellent, with no dents or splits. There is a small dog to the centre of the bowl, commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Maker :- John Lampfert. Date :- London 1759. Length :- 36 cms. Bowl width :- 9.5 cms.
