A high quality 5-pillar mechanism of 8-day duration. A dead-beat escapement with brass cased weights and a heavy regulator pendulum with wooden rod. Hourly bell striking. John Gartley of Aberdeen is recorded in Whytes' 'Scottish Clock and Watchmakers' book as working from 1783-1823. Height 7ft 4/ 223 cm.
