A good oak 18th Century Welsh dresser and rack. The upper section with a moulded cornice and a pierced fretwork shaped frieze, having two fixed oak shelves. The base with a two plank top of pegged construction above an arrangement of three block fronted oak drawers with brass swan neck handles, flanked by panelled cupboard doors, which open to reveal storage to the left hand door and a single oak shelf to the right hand section. Having typical Georgian Period "H" hinges, supported on stile feet and with panelled ends. Welsh Circa 1750-1760
 Dimensions: 68" wide x 23" deep x 72" high Condition: This dresser is in excellent condition and of superb colour and patination throughout. The rack possibly has been reduced in height at sometime in its life. The brass handles are 18th Century but not the original and there are some marks to the front where the doors have had "butterfly" catches in the past.
