Description

Fine pair of Edwardian mahogany console or centre tables by Ashby Tabb of Liverpool c.1910. An imposing design with solid mahogany tops over a moulded frieze raised on four splendid reeded column legs on large block feet protected with heavy gauge brass kick plates. Probably originally designed for a public library or bank perhaps the design is carried around all four sides suggesting they stood in the centre of a room. The Liverpool designer and artist Ashby Tabb, (whose company operated under the same name) is best known for quality commercial work in hotels and public buildings and later (as part of Heaton Tabb & Co) for the White Star Liners built by Harland and Wolff.
