It has barley twist side supports and Jacobean revival details to the panels. A very decorative piece with lovely age and colour to the oak. Construction/Wood: Solid Oak / Plywood Central Panels Condition Report: Some slight give to the frame - because of its height, it would benefit being attached to the wall as could be unstable with heavy coats hung up. Will be supplied with fixings for this. A few marks commensurate with age. The bottom hooks are period replacements. A few old worm holes to the back panel which have been treated with worm killer as a precaution. Lacking drip trays. Split to the top right hand panel.
