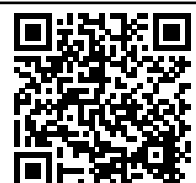

There is a full English hallmark for the highly collectible assay office of Chester and the year 1898. The makers initials are also present for John Millward Banks. The firm was established in 1863 in Birmingham with manufacturing premises at 6 Northampton Street, Birmingham and Showroom at 12, 14 Beake Street, Regent Street, London.
