Description

Maud M Turner (1862 -1947), 'Alone', watercolour, signed and Exhibited at the Royal Academy. c1900. 100cms by 67 cms Image only. Currently being re framed A British painter. She was the second youngest of a family of six. The family was very well to do and lived in the Boltons - Chelsea, London. Unfortunately there are no records regarding Maude's education or when, how and why she took up painting, but as an adult she exhibited prolifically from 1891 to 1908 at the 'Dudley' and 'New Dudley Gallery' London (50 paintings) the 'Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolours' (2 paintings) the 'Society of Women Artists' also in London. (23 paintings). Her work entitled 'Her First Sitting' was selected for the 1903 Summer Exhibition at the Royal Academy. Maude worked and lived in London between 1891-1892. She moved to Wimborne, Dorset in 1893, and took up residence at Melbury Lodge, most likely with her father who is recorded living there at one time. Melbury Lodge exists today and has been described by a local historian as an "unimposing private dwelling house". Maude Turner, who remained a spinster throughout her long life relocated to Kensington, London, in 1911, and die...
